APPROVAL OF THE CONSENT AGENDA

A MOTION was made by T. Berkheiser and seconded by N. Walker, with all members in favor, to approve the January 18, 2022 meeting minutes.

A MOTION was made by N. Walker and seconded by T. Cassidy, with all members in favor, to approve the Sussex County Health Department Public Health Nursing Monthly Municipal Report for December 2021 & January 2022.

ITEMS REMOVED FROM CONSENT AGENDA FOR DISCUSSION

No items were removed from the Consent Agenda for discussion.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Food Handler's/Vending Machine/Pet Shop/Kennel Licenses 2022

N. Walker asked Secretary D. Juarez if Newton has responded to the letters sent out via mail. Secretary D. Juarez stated nothing has been returned and a final notice will be issued for Pet & Vending Machine Applications.

2. Notice of Violation 12 Glenbrook Dr.

Sussex County Department of Health J. McDonough stated in September there was a large amount of rainfall causing the basement to flood. Sussex County Department of Health J. McDonough responded and there was a strong smell. J. McDonough gave the landlord 90 days to fix the septic. A few months past and J. McDonough did not hear back. J. McDonough extended the repair for the landlord another 2 months because the landlord moved and did not get the letter. Now, the tank is situated under an addition that was built prior to. No one wants to pump out the septic because of the confined space the septic is in. Sussex County Department of Health J. McDonough went to the Andover Joint Municipal Court to issue a summons. The anticipated court date is April 13, 2022.

N. walker asked J. McDonough what happens when someone builds over a septic tank. Sussex County Department of Health J. McDonough stated it is not allowed the addition was approved and built prior to the landlord's ownership and a mud room was built above it with a crawl space to access the septic tank. However, if you try and open up a septic tank in an enclosed space there is little to no oxygen in there and the gas will come out and can potentially cause death.

T. Berkheiser asked Sussex County Department of Health J. McDonough has received any complaints from the tenants. Sussex County Department of Health J. McDonough stated he has not received any complaints. J. McDonough had a discussion with the tenants and the tenants stated when there is heavy rainfall the basement fills back up however, they have not made a formal complaint for him to go back out. T. Berkheiser stated he received an informal complaint from the tenants stating their dogs had gotten sick from contaminated puddles in the yard. J. McDonough stated a complaint was never called into the office and if they did, he would have gone back out to take more pictures to strengthen the case.

N. Walker asked Vice Chairman E. Hayes if there were puddles in the yard, would that mean the septic field is starting to deteriorate. Vice Chairman E. Hayes stated that the location of the house has stream near by and it is swampy behind there. The new septic needs to be able to handle the swamp. N. Walker asked if you can have a septic within 250ft off of wetlands. Vice Chairman E. Hayes stated it is an existing house. Sussex County Department of Health J. McDonough stated if the new septic tank is that close to wetlands an advanced treatment unit would need to be installed.

A discussion was made between N. Walker and Sussex County Department of Health J. McDonough in regards to septic sizes and bedrooms at 80 Plotts road.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Violation Notice – Friendly's sent out 2/10/22 and same letter to Our Lady Mt. Carmel, Three Silos, & Wine Traders on 02/28/2022

Vice Chairman E. Hayes asked Secretary D. Juarez if she received any response back Friendly's, Our Lady Mt. Carme, Three Silos, and Wine Traders. Secretary D. Juarez stated Friendly's turned in their Food Handler's application as well as Food Handler Certificates. Secretary D. Juarez stated Our Lady of Mt. Carmel turned in their Food Handler's application as well as Food Handler Certificates. Secretary D. Juarez a response has not been received from Three Silos or Wine Traders.

2. Notice to Newton Vet – 15 days to respond Vending & Pet License

Vice Chairman E. Hayes asked Secretary D. Juarez about the notice sent to Newton Veterinary Hospital. Secretary D. Juarez stated there has not been any response from Newton Veterinary Hospital since the 15-day letter was mailed out. Secretary D. Juarez stated a final notice will be mailed next week. N. Walker stated Newton Veterinary Hospital may be under new management. E. Hayes stated to call Newton Veterinary Hospital to get a new mailing address. Secretary D. Juarez stated she will follow up with a phone call to get the information on their corporate office.

3. Retail/Food Establishments Use of Food Truck Letter

Secretary D. Juarez stated a packet was made to facilitate the information on protocols for Food Trucks and permits. Secretary D. Juarez stated the Township Committee is working on an Ordinance for Food Trucks in Hampton Township. The packet was created with a letter for establishments holding Food Trucks with a Food Handler's application, Sussex County Department of Health Temporary Food Event application, and a Fire Inspection application. The letters were sent to Major Kia, Angry Erik's, and Tractor supply because they are holding Food Trucks. Vice Chairman E. Hayes stated to look into a Veteran's Peddlers license for Veterans.

Vice Chairman E. Hayes asked Sussex County Department of Health JM about the Paulinskill Water Cleanup. Sussex County Department of Health, J. McDonough stated the Paulinskill Water Cleanup may take place in the Fall however, there is no set date.
