# **OLD BUSINESS**

#### 1. 12 GLENBROOK DR

Sussex County Health Official J. McDonough stated another court date was set for the ongoing septic tank failure at 12 Glenbrook Dr. on May 10th, 2023. The septic tank has been failing for approximately two (2) years and has not been remediated. At the most recent court date on May 10th, the owner of the property was still unable to appear in court due to his incarceration for a dissimilar offense. Mr. J. McDonough stated he has been in contact with the owner's father who hired a septic system company to pump the tank out. Mr. J. McDonough stated after the tank is pumped, the owner will need to hire an engineer to inspect the septic tank to ensure it is not malfunctioning. Mr. J. McDonough stated he visited the property and confirmed what was said from the owner's father was accurate. During the visit, there was a visible pipe in the floor and a septic company was contacted to pump the tank out. The tenants anticipate on moving out of the rental, however, Mr. J. McDonough stated when the tenants move out there will no longer be an issue at the property until someone else moves in.

Secretary D. Juarez stated she spoke with the Construction Official R. Huber to make sure if the tenants do move out, a certificate of occupancy is not to be issued until the issue is remediated.

# 1. Site Investigation Report & Unrestricted Use RAO-JCP&L

Chairman D. Hansen stated the Site Investigation Report & Unrestricted Use RAO was issued to remove and remediate a 4,000-gallon gasoline tank and 10,000-gallon diesel tank at eh JCP&L location in Hampton Township. The Site Investigation Report was signed off on by the NJ DEP and another cleanup will be needed for the leaking transformers.

2. Windy Acres Resort – License approved by Township Committee April 25, 2023 for 2023 season
