Program Descriptions

CHC-Well-child care for children from birth to 5 years old (school entry). Includes age-appropriate parent guidance, physical exams, vaccinations, and screening (hearings, vision, blood lead, anemia and urine). No fee for children who are under-insured or hav

Communicable Disease Fieldwork-Public Health Nurses investigate communicable disease cases in order to gather data used to control disease and ensure public safety. Surveillance of disease trends and public education about diseases and their prevention. Reporting of communicable disease

Flu, Pneu, Td Clinic-Flu (influenza), pneumococcal, and Tdap (tetanus and pertussis) vaccines offered at various locations within the County during the fall and winter in preparation for flu season. Fee for people under 65; no fee for people 65 and older.

Healthcheck Clinic-Multi-purpose adult clinic at the Sussex County Health Center. Offers adult vaccines, BP screening, BMI calculation, medication management, health maintenance assistance, and nutrition counseling along with nurse consulation for an array of health issues.

NJCEED Clinic-NJ Cancer Education and Early Detection Program, with grant funding from Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the State, provides comprehensive breast, cervical, prostate and colorectal cancer education, outreach screening and case managem

Public Service/Public Education Given-Educational programs given to the community.

School Immunization Audit-Yearly audit of preschool, elementary, middle, and high school student immunization records to ensure compliance with New Jersey law immunization requirements.

CONSENT AGENDA ITEMS TO BE DISCUSSED SEPARATELY

Safe Water Complaint Investigation on 2/7/2017 at Northwest Christian School

Health Inspector C. Whitehead stated that the water at Northwest Christian School is fine, report was made because the Nitrate results for 2016 were submitted late to the state. There is no further action needed.

Complaint Investigation on 2/7/2017 at 14 Church Road

Health Inspector C. Whitehead stated that a new septic is being installed at 14 Church Road and the resident at 16 Church Road was concerned that the new septic would be too close to his well. Health Inspector C. Whitehead measured the distance from the new septic to the complainant's well and found that they are 100' apart. She told the complainant that the septic system is an upgrade from the failing cesspool that was there and that it is an improvement over what the neighbor previously had.

Facilities Correspondence on 3/21/2017 at Ho Ho V

Health Inspector C. Whitehead stated that the correspondence was from the County of Sussex to Ho Ho V stating that since their establishment was rated "Conditionally Satisfactory" and that required a re-inspection by the Health Department. The correspondence stated that there is a re-inspection fee of \$100 payable to the County of Sussex.

OLD BUSINESS

1. 129 Route 519 Update: Health Inspector C. Whitehead

Health Inspector C. Whitehead stated that she went to investigate 129 Route 519 which is a home that burnt down a year ago and not much progress has been made on cleaning up the rest of the home and other debris. She stated that there is nothing from a Health Department standpoint that she can do. She has referred the complaint to the Building and Zoning Inspector, Bob Huber, for further action.
