



NOTICE TO UNAFFILIATED VOTERS ON THE “ALL FUTURE ELECTIONS” VOTE-BY-MAIL LIST

Do you want to vote in the June Primary Election?

You are currently registered as an Unaffiliated Voter, commonly referred to as an Independent.

Per State Law, to vote in the June Primary Election in New Jersey, you must be a member of either the Democratic Party or the Republican Party.

As a voter who has applied and been approved to receive Vote by Mail Ballots in All Future Elections, you are entitled to be sent a ballot; **however**, to receive your ballot, you will first have to declare your party affiliation.

Yes, I want to Vote by Mail

- You must declare yourself a member of either the **Democratic or Republican** Party by:

Updating your registration online at <https://voter.svrs.nj.gov/register>

or

By completing, signing, and returning the enclosed political party affiliation declaration form.



- The deadline to have your declaration form received is **April 12, 2023**.
- Once your party declaration form is received and processed, you will be mailed your Vote by Mail Ballot.

Yes, I want to Vote In-Person

- You can declare your party at the polls in-person on Election Day or during Early Voting.
- Your sample ballot, arriving in late May, will provide more details about polling places and polling hours.
- Since you have not been sent a Vote by Mail ballot, you will be able to vote on a machine.

No, I do not want to Vote

- No further action is needed.
- No ballot for the Primary Election will be sent.
- You will remain an Unaffiliated voter.
- You will continue to receive ballots for all other elections.
