FAFSA/NJAFAA INFORMATION

For KRHS graduating classes of 2025 & 2026, each graduating high school senior is required by law, as part of New Jersey's new <u>graduation requirement</u>, to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the NJ Alternative Financial Aid Application (NJAFAA).

The FAFSA gives students access to the largest source of financial aid to pay for college or vocational school. Through completing the FAFSA, students can be considered for federal financial aid, including Pell grants, work-study programs, and loans. In addition, many states and colleges, as well as some private financial aid providers, use FAFSA information to determine students' eligibility for aid.

The FAFSA is an opportunity to have access to the resources that are needed to consider and enter postsecondary education – whether it be 2-year, 4-year, or technical school. In addition, students who are NJ residents but do not meet the requirements for FAFSA, may consider the NJAFAA as an option. The NJAFAA enables students to receive state financial assistance to support their postsecondary college and career goals.

If you do not qualify for the FAFSA or the NJ Alternative Financial Aid Application or request that your child be exempt from this graduation requirement, parents/guardians should complete the <u>FAFSA/NJAFAA Exemption Form</u> and submit it to your student's school counselor by May 1st of your student's senior vear.

FAFSA completion benefits ALL students:

The U.S. Department of Education's Office of Federal Student Aid provides more than \$120 billion in grants, loans, and work-study funds each year to help pay for college or career school. Visit <u>StudentAid.gov</u> today to learn how to pay for your higher education. The FAFSA must be completed to apply for grants, loans, and work-study. All financial information is kept confidential. Many students are eligible to receive financial aid from the federal government to help pay for college or career school. Age race or field of study will not affect eligibility for college or career school. Age, race, or field of study will not affect eligibility for federal student aid.

Many college/university websites and fafsa.gov provide a financial aid estimator Many college/university websites and <u>tatsa.gav</u> provide a tinancial aid estimator to estimate how much financial assistance students may receive, Financial need increases with college cost and some colleges can cost more than \$65,000 a year. Many of these colleges, state agencies, and scholarship foundations require the FAFSA to award scholarships and grants to middle– and upper-middle–class students attending expensive schools. The most generous private colleges, for example, award need-based aid to some students from families earning more than \$200,000 a year. FAFSA is a prerequisite for Direct Unsubsidized Loans, Grad PUIS Loans, and Parent PUIS. There have are available without repard to PLUS Loans, and Parent PLUS. These loans are available without regard to demonstrated financial need and have lower interest rates than private loans.

NJAFAA may be an option for some students:

Complete the <u>NJAFAA</u> application if you are not a United States citizen or eligible noncitizen and meet all of the following criteria: • Attended a New Jersey high school for at least three (3) years • Graduated from a New Jersey high school or received the equivalent of a high record of the value berger in the value of the

school diploma in New Jersey

 Registered for Selective Service (male students only)
 Are able to file an affidavit stating that you have filed an application to legalize your immigration status or will file an application as soon as you are eligible to do so

Many colleges/universities can assist with the FAFSA/NJAFAA applications. We partner with Sussex County Community College & the Higher Education Student Assistance Authority (HESAA) to provide a FAFSA information right in the fall and SCCC also offers FAFSA Workshops to help students and families complete the application.

If you do not qualify for the FAFSA or the NJ Alternative Financial Aid Application OR are requesting an exemption from the graduation requirement, parents/guardians should complete the FAFSA/NJAFAA Exemption Form and submit it to their student's school counselor by May 1st of the student's senior

Please log onto your Parent Portal to see if your child has any outstanding obligations, including negative cafeteria balances, for the 2023-2024 school year. If the obligation is not met the following will be withheld until any and all obligations have been fulfilled:

Student's grades and report card information (withheld)

You can access your Parent Portal using the following URL: https://www.fridayparentportal.com/kittatinny or through the Kittatinny website @ www.krhs.net, click on the Parent tab and then the Parent Portal.

- Outstanding Fees: Once on the Parent Portal, scroll down under Menu and click on "Fines." If your child has an outstanding obligation, it will be displayed on the "Fines" page.
- Negative Cafeteria Balances: Once on the Parent Portal under Menu, click on "Food Services" to view your child's account. If your child has a negative cafeteria balance, you have been receiving weekly notifications on the amount due.

You can either send in a check made payable to KRHS for the outstanding obligation or pay online with PaySchools Central @ https://payschoolscentral.com/. If you have not registered for a PaySchools account, you will find the PaySchools Central account setup guide through Kittatinny's website @ www.krhs.net, click on the Parent tab, Parent Resources then Payschool.
